What is Uncompromised?

Uncompromised is a program sponsored by the Michigan Conference Women's Ministries Department to address and train women and girls in their choices of purity, modesty, and sexual behavior. This program seeks to remind women that no matter what choices a person has made, that every woman has an opportunity through Christ to be called ***Uncompromised***. Jeremiah 17:8 says if we are planted in Christ, drink deeply of Him, draw from His word, seek Him daily, and gain strength from prayer, that we can remain fruitful and obedient in drought or under pressure. ***Uncompromised*** is designed to help us do just that!

Bold in Purity

God is working hard to lift our heart and minds from the base elements of the world and place them on what is pure and holy. This means more than saying no to impurity or sex, it means saying YES to Christ! Saying YES requires us guard what we watch, read, listen to, and think about. ***Uncompromised*** addresses how to say YES to Christ and how to keep that commitment in difficult times. We must be bold in our decisions to remain pure!

Beautiful in Christ

We women have a responsibility to dress and conduct ourselves in a way that does not cause people to question our commitment to purity and holiness. How we dress is a direct reflection of what is going on inside our hearts. 1 Cor 8:9 reminds us that the exercise of our liberty in Christ should not cause someone else to stumble. If we have been freed from the guilt and shame of impurity, we have an obligation to be watchful of our behavior. Both men and women need to be committed to purity in the heart and mind, which will be reflected in the life. ***Uncompromised*** seeks to bring the commitment of the heart into the actions of daily life.

Ways *Uncompromised* can help your church:

- Teach and train woman and youth principles of modesty in church worship and daily life.
- Educate church leaders and parents in ways to guide their members or children in the purity choices they will face. To show the direct link between choice and consequence.
- To help women connect with Christ as their source of strength for desiring and living out a life long commitment to purity and holiness.
