☞ Pray for Safe Travel ☜

Protect the women attending as they travel, and give them a trip filled with joy!

Psalm 5:11-12:

But let all who take refuge in you be glad; let them ever sing for joy. Spread your protection over them, that those who love your name may rejoice in you. For surely, O LORD, you bless the righteous; you surround them with your favor as with a shield.

☞ Pray for Women's Relationships with One Another ☜

Help women grow in humility and look for ways to serve one another!

Philippians 2:3-5:

Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves. Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others. Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus.



Enable women to forgive others and experience the freedom that accompanies true forgiveness!

Colossians 3:12-14:

Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.



May they grow in love!

1 Thessalonians 3:12:

May the Lord make your love increase and overflow for each other and for everyone else.

May women be encouraged!

Colossians 3:16:

Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom, and as you sing psalms, hymns and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God.



Help women respect and support their church leadership!

1 Thessalonians 5:12-15:

Respect those who work hard among you, who are over you in the Lord and who admonish you. Hold them in the highest regard in love because of their work. Live in peace with each other. And we urge you, [sisters], warn those who are idle, encourage the timid, help the weak, be patient with everyone. Make sure that nobody pays back wrong for wrong, but always try to be kind to each other and to everyone else.



Lord, may their interaction be filled with joy and gentleness!

Philippians 4:4-5:

Rejoice in the Lord always... Rejoice! Let your gentleness be evident to all.

☪ Pray for Women Who Face Personal Challenges ☪

Give wisdom to those women who ask.

James 1:5-6:

If any of you lacks wisdom, [she] should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to [her]. But when [she] asks, [she] must believe and not doubt.

Grant peace as women trust in You.

Isaiah 26:3:

You will keep in perfect peace [her] whose mind is steadfast, because [she] trusts in you.

Strengthen the weak.

Isaiah 40:28-31:

Do you not know? Have you not heard? The Lord is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He will not grow tired or weary, and his understanding no one can fathom. He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak. Even youths grow tired and weary, and young [women] stumble and fall; but those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.

☪☪

Lord, assure the women walking through difficult circumstances that You are with them.

Isaiah 43:1-2:

...the Lord says—"Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have summoned you by name; you are mine. When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned; the flames will not set you ablaze."

Give them hope and rest!

Psalms 62:5-7:

Find rest, O my soul, in God alone; my hope comes from him. He alone is my rock and my salvation; he is my fortress, I will not be shaken. My salvation and my honor depend on God; he is my mighty rock, my refuge.

Restore their joy!

Psalms 51:10-12:

Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. Do not cast me from your presence or take your Holy Spirit from me. Restore to me the joy of your salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me.

Calm their anxious hearts and minds.

Philippians 4:6-7:

Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

Strengthen the women who are struggling in their faith or with temptation!

Hebrews 4:14-16:

Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has gone through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to the faith we profess. For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are—yet was without sin. Let us then approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.

☪ Pray for Altar Times ☪

Lord, may women come to You in repentance!

Psalm 51:1-2:

Have mercy on me, O God, according to your unfailing love; according to your great compassion blot out my transgressions. Wash away all my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin.



May women pour out their hearts to You!

Psalm 62:8:

Trust in him at all times, O people; pour out your hearts to him, for God is our refuge.



As women seek You, may they find complete fulfillment in their relationship with You!

Psalm 63:1-5:

O God, you are my God, earnestly I seek you; my soul thirsts for you, my body longs for you, in a dry and weary land where there is no water. I have seen you in the sanctuary and beheld your power and your glory. Because your love is better than life, my lips will glorify you. I will praise you as long as I live, and in your name I will lift up my hands. My soul will be satisfied as with the richest of foods; with singing lips my mouth will praise you.



May they experience Your presence!

Psalm 16:11:

You have made known to me the path of life; you will fill me with joy in your presence, with eternal pleasures at your right hand.



Give the women times of refreshing!

Acts 3:19:

Repent, then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord.

Lord, assure them of Your incredible love!

Ephesians 3:16-19:

I pray that out of [the Father's] glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have power, together with all the saints, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.



Lord, assure them of Your great care!

Psalm 17:6-8:

I call on you, O God, for you will answer me; give ear to me and hear my prayer. Show the wonder of your great love, you who save by your right hand those who take refuge in you from their foes. Keep me as the apple of your eye; hide me in the shadow of your wings.



Lord, encourage the women to ask for prayer!

Heal the sick in body, soul, and mind!

James 5:13-16:

Is any one of you in trouble? [She] should pray. Is anyone happy? Let [her] sing songs of praise. Is any one of you sick? [She] should call the elders of the church to pray over [her] and anoint [her] with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise [her] up. If [she] has sinned, [she] will be forgiven. Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous [woman] is powerful and effective.

☪ Pray for Growth in Spiritual Maturity—*Whatever it Takes!* ☪

Give the women discernment that flows from a heart of love!

Philippians 1:9-11:

And this is my prayer: that your love may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight, so that you may be able to discern what is best and may be pure and blameless until the day of Christ, filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ—to the glory and praise of God.

☪☪

Lord, may they grow in You—fulfilling Your plans for their lives!

Ephesians 4:12-16:

Prepare God's people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ. Then we will no longer be infants, tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching... Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will in all things grow up into him who is the Head, that is, Christ. From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work.

☪☪

Help the women to understand the purpose in their trials!

James 1:2-4:

Consider it pure joy, my [sisters], whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith develops perseverance. Perseverance must finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything.

Give the women a desire to “make every effort” to grow spiritually!

2 Peter 1:5-8:

Make every effort to add to your faith goodness; and to goodness, knowledge; and to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, perseverance; and to perseverance, godliness; and to godliness, [sisterly] kindness; and to [sisterly] kindness, love. For if you possess these qualities in increasing measure, they will keep you from being ineffective and unproductive in your knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.

☪☪

Lord, give them an overwhelming hunger to know You more, and allow them to experience Your power for living!

Ephesians 1:17-19:

I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better. I pray also that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints, and his incomparably great power for us who believe. That power is like the working of his mighty strength...

Help the women to understand that humility and gentleness are signs of spiritual maturity!

Ephesians 4:1-3:

I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received. Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love. Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace.
